2023 Spring Bash Raffle
Official Rules and Regulations

GENERAL CONTEST PROVISIONS

1. By purchasing a ticket, the purchaser agrees to all of the rules and regulations as provided herein.
2. The interpretation and application of the rules and regulations shall be at the sole and absolute discretion of the Friends of Whitney Young and shall be binding upon all raffle participants.
3. The drawing will be held on Saturday, March 25, 2023 at 9:00 PM at the Whitney Young High School Spring Bash taking place at Venue West. No tickets will be sold after 8:00 PM on March 25, 2023 if purchased from a Friends of Whitney Young authorized representative or from the school facility.
4. The winner does not need to be present to claim the prize.
5. The person with the winning ticket assumes all fees, local, state, and federal taxes (including but not limited to income taxes based on the value of all prizes won and awarded). The IRS has taken the position that the amounts paid for chances in drawings or lotteries for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions.
6. The winner of the raffle agrees that his/her name and/or likeness may be disclosed and may be used by Friends of Whitney Young for publicity and be published in area newspapers and announced on Friends of Whitney Young and Whitney Young website.
7. By entering this drawing, each participant releases the Friends of Whitney Young from any and all liability for injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by participating in the drawing or resulting from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of the prize. The winner agrees to indemnify and hold the Friends of Whitney Young and all employees and volunteers of and for Friends of Whitney Young harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of participating in the drawing or the winner's acceptance or use of the prize.

II. TICKETS AND PRIZE SELECTION

1. Only one eligible person may be entered in the raffle per ticket sold. If the name of more than one person is submitted with a ticket purchase and that ticket is selected as a winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed the Holder of that ticket and declared the winner. The Friends of Whitney Young reserves the right to reject any entry.
2. All defective or physically altered entries will be immediately disqualified by the Friends of Whitney Young. Prior to the drawing, Friends of Whitney Young will make a reasonable effort to notify the individual and/ or entity that submits any rejected or disqualified entry to advise that the entry has been rejected or disqualified by attempting to contact that individual using the information that was supplied at the time of the purchase.
3. An individual can purchase as many tickets as they wish subject to availability.
4. Tickets can be purchased from an authorized Friends of Whitney Young representative or by going to Whitney Young High School, 211 South Laflin, Chicago, IL 60607, 773-534-7500. The cost of tickets will depend upon the point of purchase and the number of tickets purchased. 5. At the sole discretion of the Friends of Whitney Young, tickets purchased from an authorized Friends of Whitney Young representative may be paid for in U.S. cash or check or credit card.

III. SELECTION OF WINNER

1. The winner will be selected by drawing. The drawing will be held on Saturday, March 25, 2023, at 9:00PM at Venue West, 221 N. Paulina, Chicago, IL.
2. Immediately following the drawing, a subsequent drawing will be held to select the back-up-winner in the event that the initial winner is unable to accept the prize due to any applicable law (e.g., federal, state or local). Second and third place prizes will consist of an electric scooter and an Apple iPad.
3. If not physically present, the initial winner will be notified according to contact information provided to Friends of Whitney Young at the time of ticket purchase. If the prize winner cannot be located by 5:00 pm on April 7, 2023, after attempting to make contact through the information provided at the time of purchasing the ticket, the back-up winner shall be declared the winner and contacted by an authorized Friends of Whitney Young representative.

IV. CLAIMING OF PRIZE

In order to collect the prize, a ticket winner must deliver to Friends of Whitney Young:

1. A sworn affidavit of eligibility in accordance with these Official Rules and Regulations and applicable law, stating, inter alia, that he or she is a legal resident of the United States, at least 18 years old, and receipt of the prize, to the best of his or her knowledge, is not prohibited by any applicable law (e.g., federal, state or local).
2. Such written information as is required by any applicable taxing authorities or under any other related statutory provisions.
3. His or her Social Security Number.
4. Proof of identity in forms satisfactory to the Friends of Whitney Young showing that the person claiming the prize is the same person who is named on the winning ticket.
5. W-2G, Form 5754 or similar tax form for tax withholding purposes.
